

# **ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

OF

ORANGE COUNTY MOUNTAIN BIKE ASSOCIATION

*Formally known as SHARE - Concerned Cyclists of Crystal Cove. Cyclists of Crystal Cove is recognized as a non-profit 501 (c)(3) organization (33-0499698)*

## **Article I – NAME**

The name of this organization name will be changed from SHARE - Concerned Cyclists of Crystal Cove to Orange County Mountain Bike Association, hereby known as OCMTBA.

## **Article II – PURPOSE**

- A. This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for public and charitable purposes.
- B. The specific purpose of this corporation is to create, enhance and preserve great trail experiences for mountain bikers in Orange County, California, and to create a bicycle friendly community through cycling awareness, safety advocacy and promotion of bicycling for fun, fitness, and transportation.

## **Article IV – ORGANIZATION**

- A. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

B. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda and otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

C. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

D. This corporation is not organized, nor shall it be operated, for pecuniary gain or profit, and it does not contemplate the distribution of gains, profits, or dividends to the members thereof or to any private shareholder, as defined for purposes of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or individual.

### **Article V**

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for the charitable purposes, and which has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
